NOTICE OF CLASS ACTION DISMISSAL

*Notice of Dismissal*

By order of the Ontario Superior Court of Justice, dated July 10, 2023, the proposed class action, *Jack v. Saxton Investments LTD., et al.* (Ontario Court File No: 29775) **has been dismissed**. Please read this notice carefully for more information.

The Ontario Superior Court of Justice authorized this notice. This is not a solicitation from a lawyer.

*What was the proposed class action about?*

The proposed class action against Saxton Investments Ltd. and various other defendants was commenced in the Ontario courts by notice of action on 6 October 1998. The class action was brought on behalf of individual claimants that had invested in Saxton Investments Ltd. or one of the various companies associated with Saxton. The claimants alleged a variety of misconduct associated with their investments, including misrepresentation, breach of fiduciary duty, breach of contract, breach of the duty of good faith, and breaches of the Securities Act.

The plaintiff never served a certification motion and took no real steps in this matter since commencing the claim. There has been no adjudication on the merits of the claims.

*What does this dismissal mean for you?*

The limitation period for individual claimants to file their own legal action against Saxton Investments Ltd. was suspended upon the commencement of the class action on 6 October 1998. However, since the proposed class action has been dismissed, limitation periods have resumed running as of July 10, 2023. If there is any time left on any limitation period that may apply to you, on the expiry of your limitation period, a right to sue or complain may be extinguished.
